### REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES FOR ENTRY:

- Contest is open to anyone ages 16 and up.
- MUST be able to deliver your art sculpture to the Harmon Museum Armstrong Event Center 105 S Broadway St in Lebanon during museum hours on Friday June 6 between 10am – 4pm.
- All artwork must be REMOVED from the Harmon Museum Armstrong Event Center 105 S Broadway St in Lebanon on Saturday June 7 between 5pm – 6pm.
- \*\*We are not responsible for sculptures left on the premises after June 7 at 6pm.\*\*
  
- Artwork must be designed and built by its owner, using mostly repurposed, recycled and/or reclaimed materials. Artists must submit their info with a photo of their work
- Repurposed artwork cannot exceed 2 feet (wide) by 2 feet (long) by 3 feet (tall). Entries exceeding these limits will be disqualified.
- Use of biohazardous items (needles, condoms, used bandages, or items otherwise to be deemed hazardous or unsanitary to others) is NOT permitted.
- Use of glass is NOT permitted.
- Repurposed artwork must be freestanding.
- Artwork must be acceptable for public viewing, with no offensive language or visuals.
- \*\*We reserve the right to remove artworks not suitable for the general public at our own discretion.\*\*
- Artwork must be the original work of the artist, with any reproduction items crediting the original artist.
  
- Entrants must register and submit a photo of artwork to be submitted via the Google Doc registration link by May 23 at 11:59pm.
- I allow the use of photography and/or video of my project for marketing or another purpose.

-How Recycled Art Will Be Judged:

25% Percentage of repurposed or reclaimed materials

25% Originality

25% Creativity

25% Complexity

You will be contacted via email after the May 23 deadline with confirmation and additional instructions.
