PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS: Senior art students from the following Warren County School Districts: Lebanon, Kings, Mason, Franklin, Carlisle, Springboro, Waynesville, Little Miami, Fenwick and Warren County Career Center

APPLICATION PROCESS: High School art teachers may nominate **up to 4** students from any of the listed school districts.

1. The student must be a senior.
2. Two works may be submitted by each of the students.
3. Works should be presented matted, if appropriate. Museum will provide display hanging. (Framing is not required.)
4. Work should have been produced within the last 2 years.
EACH entry **MUST** be accompanied by a **COMPLETED** entry form. (Work will **NOT** be accepted without a **COMPLETED** form) and taken to Harmon Museum by the deadline date (4:30pm on 4/10/2021)
5. Works will be available for sale during the week of the exhibit. • If a student does not want to sell their work it must be marked NFS (Not for Sale) on the entry form. • The Student/Art Teacher **MUST LIST** the sale price on the entry form. **NOTE:** If the student wishes to sell their work, the museum will add 10% to the sale price and keep that 10% for the processing of the sale. **THE STUDENT WILL RECEIVE THE FULL SALE PRICE.**
